God is good!

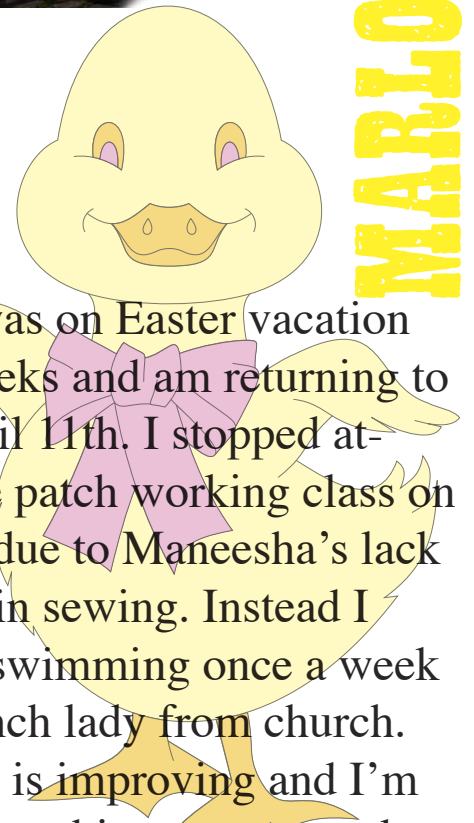
DID YOU KNOW
