We are blessed to have a **church family** that warmly welcomed us back to Canada and are helping to encourage and train us for ministry.

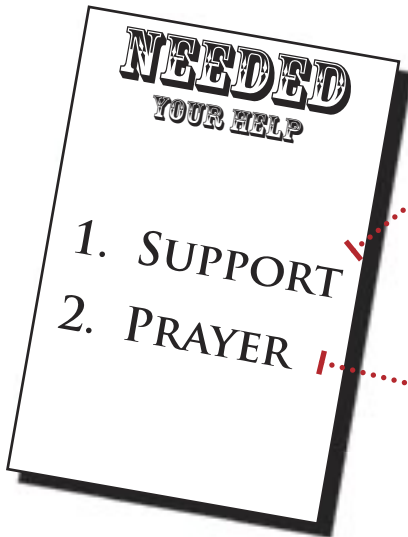
We praise God for a reliable vehicle & a warm dry place to live. Though at times, funds are limited, we praise God we have never gone hungry.

I've been asked to use my tradesman skills to help further this ministry, as well as my culinary training to feed short-term mission teams that come to work on the project.

Marlo's main goal for this time in LaChute is to improve her fluency in French through relationships in the church and neighborhood. No doubt, Maneesha will have playmates among the local children.
